Travelling to Magdeburg (Elbweg, 39122 Magdeburg)

Directions

Via motorway A2

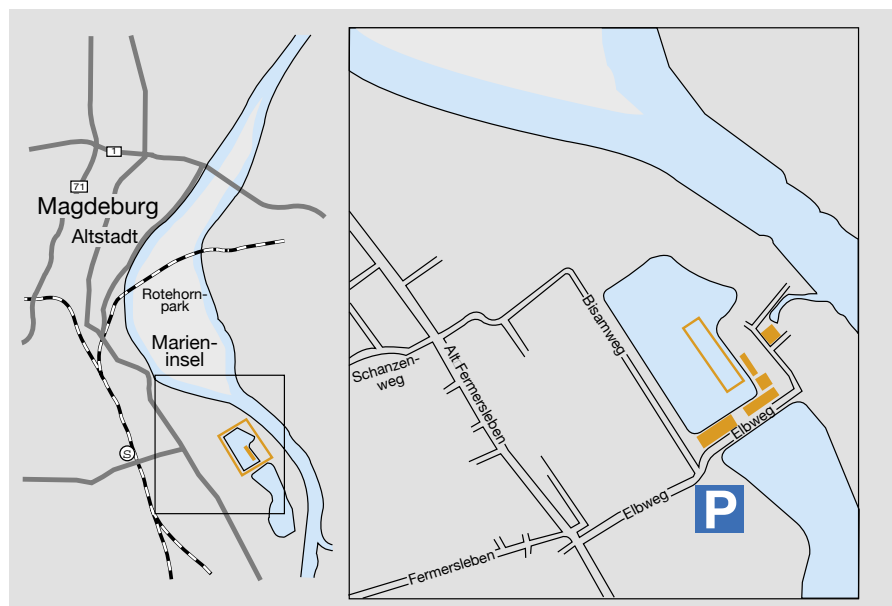
- Leave the A2 at exit Magdeburg Zentrum, taking the Magdeburg ring road (B71)
- Leave the ring road at exit Reform/Lemsdorf
- Turn left onto Kirschweg
- Drive straight on along the roads Schilfbreite and Schanzenweg to Schönebecker Straße
- Turn right at the traffic lights into Alt Fermesleben
- Follow the road for approx. 900 m
- Turn left into Elbweg at the sign "Yachthafen"
- Follow Elbweg for approx. 1.5 km

Via motorway A14

- Leave the A14 at exit Magdeburg "Sudenburg" taking the Magdeburg ring road (B81/B71)
- Leave the ring road at exit Reform/Lemsdorf
- Turn right onto Kirschweg
- Drive straight on along the roads Schilfbreite and Schanzenweg to Schönebecker Straße
- Turn right at the traffic lights into Alt Fermesleben
- Follow the road for approx. 900 m
- Turn left into Elbweg at the sign "Yachthafen"
- Follow Elbweg for approx. 1.5 km

Via Burg/Heyrothsberge

- Take the B1/Berliner Chaussee/Jerichower Straße over the 1st and 2nd bridges
- Turn left at Askanischen Platz onto Schleinufer Straße
- Follow the road to Steubenallee
- Turn left into Schönebecker Straße towards Buckau/Fermersleben
- Continue straight on until you reach Alt Fermesleben
- Follow the road for approx. 900 m
- Turn left into Elbweg at the sign "Yachthafen"
- Follow Elbweg for approx. 1.5 km



Arrival / Registration / Checking out

The regatta office is open from 09:00 on Friday 24 June 2011. It is located on the regatta site Salbker Lake II. Team captains are requested to go to the registration point (see site plan) on arrival.

On registration you will receive all necessary documents for participation in the regatta (including starting numbers, meal vouchers, rubbish sacks, T-shirts) and information and instructions about parking vehicles and boats and overnight stays at the campsite.

The number of team members given on your registration form is binding and documents will be issued accordingly. School or student identification or proof of education or training must be shown.

We also ask you to let us know the registration number of your vehicles.

- Registration must be completed by 14:00 on Friday at the latest.

Your team T-shirt for the evening competition "Best Regatta T-shirt" is to be submitted on registration, if you are taking part in the competition. Please complete the relevant registration card.

The registration point behind the grandstands is also a collecting point for information and news as well as a general meeting place.

At the end of the regatta, loaned items such as the starting numbers (two bibs) are to be returned in perfect condition. If the bibs are not returned, the starting fees for that team (€ 50) will not be returned.

Certificates and prize money will be handed out and starting fees returned at check-out.

Organisation

Approach / Boat and car parking spaces

The boat park is open from 09:00 on Friday. Vehicles transporting boats should follow the regatta staff's instructions and the signs on the regatta site. The approach is via Elbweg. To avoid impeding the traffic, drivers should start unloading the boats as soon as they have entered the regatta site and have been allotted their boat space by the organising team or at registration.

The spaces for the boats are marked with tape and the boats' numbers. After unloading, participants' vehicles may be parked in the spaces close to the regatta site. Please wait for instructions before driving into the car park.

Teams arriving on Wednesday or Thursday may park on the grassy area on Elbweg set aside for this purpose.. The boats may be temporarily stored at the campsite until Friday morning if necessary.

Boat parking

On Friday, the concrete canoes are to be brought, when called, to the weighing and measuring station near the boat park and then taken to the allotted space to be examined by the judges. Each boat will be allotted a space marked with the boat's number. Please bring supports to place the boats on (for canoes, simple aluminium folding stools with canvas seats, polystyrene blocks or similar are most suitable).

The boat park is on the grassy area by Salbker Lake. Pavilions or similar may be erected.

- The boat park will be guarded on Friday night.

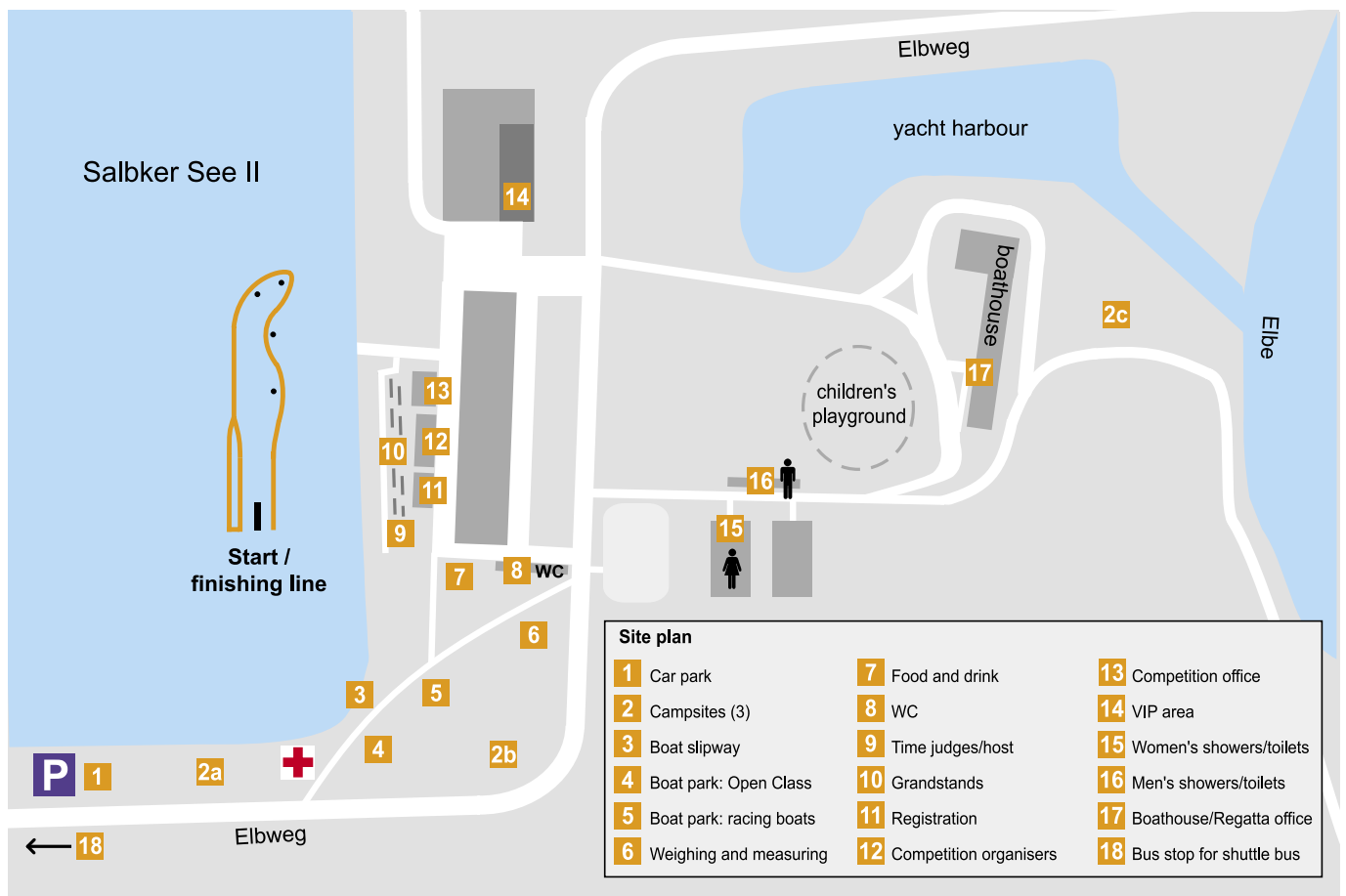
After the regatta, you are obliged to remove your boats and all other items you bring, including your waste.

Transportation of the boats before, during and after the regatta is at your



own risk. Lifting equipment or transport vehicles for the boats are not available. Slipways where the boats can be put into the water (Salbker Lake) are located right by the boat park. Lightweight boats can be stored on land again after their races. Heavy boats, e.g. those in the Open Class, can be launched via a slipway near the grandstands.

The boats should be equipped with features (e.g. rings, ropes) for tying up to the pontoon/banks. You should also bring fenders or mats to protect your boat/s (and others) in case of collisions.



Regatta race course / Regatta site

The regatta race course and the most important locations on the site such as toilets, first aid centre, car parks, regatta office and registration, and the measuring and weighing station, are marked on the site plan.

Campsite / accommodation

Tents may be erected on the two grassy areas directly on the banks of Salbker Lake and there is a slightly quieter site behind the boathouse (2a, b and c on the site plan).

Please await instructions from the regatta staff before putting up your tent. Unfortunately it is not possible to park vehicles on the campsite. After unloading, please park your vehicle immediately in the designated car parks.



Showers and toilets are open at all times. There is a shower container for the men. Women may use the shower area in the WBF e.V. administration building on the site.

Toilets are located on the regatta site and in the WBF Magdeburg e.V. administration building.

Please help to ensure that the Concrete Canoe Regatta at Salbker Lake II is a success for all concerned. We are only guests on the campsite and in the

WBF e.V.'s sanitary facilities. If you see colleagues misbehaving, please remind them of their responsibility. If serious breaches of order or cleanliness are observed, the regatta organisers reserve the right to exclude the team involved from the regatta.

Open fires are not permitted. Permission for barbecues depends on the forest fire warning level.

Hotel / Youth Hostel

Welcome Evening Event

The Welcome Evening Event will take place on Friday in the Stadthalle Magdeburg.

Start: 18:30, end: approx. 0:30. A buffet will be served from approx. 19:00.

At the beginning of the evening event, instructions about the races and competitions on Saturday will be given. For this reason it is necessary that all team captains attend.

As well as the traditional „Best Regatta T-shirt“ competition, music is planned and there will be a performance by the band RocketShop.



There will be a free bus shuttle service between the regatta site and the Stadthalle.

- To the Stadthalle from the bus stop „Elbweg Ecke Bisamweg“: from 16:30 to 18:30 (last bus)
- Return journey from the Stadthalle: from 22:30 to 0:40 (last bus)

Catering

Racing procedure

Starting numbers, boat numbers

Each boat will be given a number. The racing canoes will be numbered from 1 to 100; boats in the Open Class will be given their own number including the letters „OK“.

The boat numbers are also starting numbers for the races. If a canoe is to be raced by two teams, the second team is given the number of the first team plus 100. E.g.: the first team in canoe No.12 has the starting number 12. The second team has the number $12 + 100 = 112$.

The starting numbers (two bibs) are issued with the race documents and should be returned in good condition to the race office when checking out once the races are over. If the starting numbers are not all returned, the starting fee will not be returned to the team.

General information on the proceedings

The aim of the races on water is to determine the speed and manoeuvrability of the canoes. The WBF Magdeburg e.V. is responsible for the proper conduct of the races.

- Each race will take place in several heats. Up to five canoes may participate in each heat, but no more than four in each semi-final and final.
- The race schedule and a list of starting times for each race will be announced on the spot.
- The race organisers will decide on the participants for each heat. The second team of one canoe and the second canoe of one institute will also be decided by the race organisers. The list displayed on the day of the regatta applies.

- Teams who do not qualify directly in their heat for the next stage have a second chance in the repechage. This ensures that all teams have the chance to take part in at least two heats.

- The placings and if applicable, the times achieved in the heats decide which teams progress to the next stage.

- The women take part in separate races.

- Mixed teams (male/female) will race in the men's class.

Instructions on the races will be given on Friday evening at the Welcome Event in the Stadthalle Magdeburg.



The start

The starting times for the heats for all teams are on the list. No separate announcements are made. Each team can see when they start by looking at the list.

The concrete canoes for the next race have approximately 5 minutes before the race starts to make their way to the starting area. Canoes which are not in the starting area on time do not have a

second chance to start. So make sure you include the time for putting the boat into the water and paddling to the starting area in your calculations.

Once the canoes are in position, the starter will shout, "Attention!" After about 3 seconds, the starter will shout "Go!" to start the race.

Results

The results of each race will be shown on the information boards near the registration point and race organisers, no more than 30 minutes after the end of the race.

Later race stages

If a canoe which is being raced by two teams has to start twice within a very short time due to the race schedule, the regatta organisers reserve the right to allot the canoe to a later race.

If a canoe which is being raced by two men's or women's teams reaches the semi-final with both teams, one of the two teams must withdraw from the race.

Time penalties

- Missing one buoy: 20 seconds
- Missing more buoys: 40 seconds for each further buoy missed
- Impeding another boat (cutting in front of it): 10 seconds
- Each violation of the entry regulations e.g. inadmissible boat coating, inadmissible boat measurements: 5 to 10 seconds per race



Safety

Instructions given by supervisors and regatta staff during the regatta are to be followed at all times.

Security personnel will be present to guard the boat park and campsite on Friday night. Participants are responsib-

le for the security of their own personal property and valuables.

A fence extends from the WBF Magdeburg e.V. site into the lake to separate the site from the rest of the lake. It will be marked by a buoy. Please take care when canoeing in this area.

For your information: Salbker Lake II is not a public bathing lake. If you swim, you do this on your own responsibility.

Regatta participants found to be under the influence of intoxicating substances (e.g. alcohol, drugs) are not permitted to take part in the competitions on the water.

Life jackets

We recommend that life jackets be worn. A limited number of life jackets can be hired on the spot for a deposit of € 50 and a personal identity card.

First Aid

First aid will be provided by the DLRG (see the red cross on the site plan). During the races, a safety boat will ensure participants' safety.
